All the propaganda in the advertisements put out by the American Petroleum Institute and Dominion Power won’t change the fact that the gas that comes through this pipeline comes from fracking and fracking is not good for the environment. One can’t evaluate the pipeline alone without taking into consideration what travels in this pipeline and the processes that go into its construction. It has to be examined as a whole—from the mountain top eradication in West Virginia to the silting in the Chesapeake Bay.

Please note Executive Order #13604. In it The President of the United States says in section 3. B. i, that “outcomes for communities and the environment” must be improved. Nothing about this pipeline improves our community or the environment. The pipeline does not belong in Horizons Village, Nelson County or anywhere near here. We hope it matters to you that many voters do not want this.
