

SEND A LETTER TO FERC!

***NOW* is the time to send a letter to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) to list your Atlantic Coast Pipeline concerns!**

Atlantic Coast Pipeline docket#: CP15-554

Make your letter as long or short as you like. Most important is that FERC hears from you directly. Let's tell FERC, loud and clear, why the Atlantic Coast Pipeline is the wrong thing, in the wrong place, at the wrong time!

- ❖ At the top of your letter, identify the pipeline and docket#: Re: Atlantic Coast Pipeline- Docket #CP15-554
- ❖ Tell FERC how the pipeline will affect you, impact your property, and harm the farms, forests, streams, and rural heritage that are impotent to YOU – and that make Virginia, Augusta County, Bath County, Highland County Nelson County special.
- ❖ Tell FERC how the “ACP” will damage the George Washington National Forest and other precious wild areas, how it will encourage higher use of fossil fuel and increase climate change.
- ❖ Tell FERC that **they should restart the scoping process considering the extensive new route** through Bath and Augusta Counties and **have FERC open houses in Bath and Buckingham** (where a compressor station is proposed) Counties.
